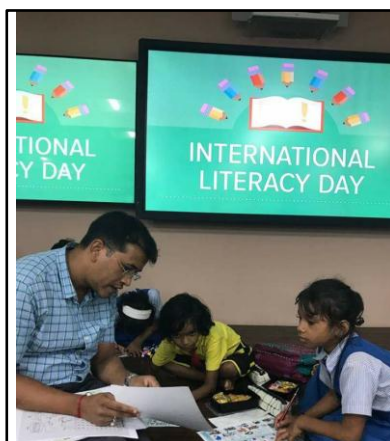


## Welspun CSR Times – September 2017

### International Literacy Day Celebration:

Welspun celebrated International Literacy Day on 8<sup>th</sup> September with different interventional activities across UK. Anjar, Mumbai, Vapi, Dahej and Mandya locations reaching out to over 3000 beneficiaries.

**Anjar:** Sessions on industrial recruitment, safety and security with adolescents was conducted. Para teachers' motivation session, plantation drive, career counseling, women empowerment sessions and street play on health and hygiene were major highlights of literacy day celebration at Anjar

**Vapi:** Poster making and essay writing competition for children, street play on drug abuse, classroom sessions by volunteers on mathematics, art and importance of cleanliness were the activities carried out at Vapi

**Dahej:** Rally and street play on importance of education followed by elocution competition to throw light on importance of education at Vadadla village.

**Mumbai:** Mentoring sessions by employees for orphan girls, fun photo session on a graduation cut out and group project work for girls received great employee participation at HD.

**Mandya:** Sessions with the primary school children by Welspun employees was conducted.

## Anjar - Education

### Gayatri Devi Vedvidyalaya:

Students of Gayatri Devi Vedvidyalaya participated in Akhil Bharatiya Vaidik Maha-Sammelan organized by "Shree Sandhya Giri Bapu and performed the Veda/ Sanskrit slokas in the program. Governor of Gujarat, Shree Om Prakash Kohli, was invited as the chief guest of the program.



### Environment

#### Tree Plantation Drive:

200 plants were planted in September at Model School, Anjar. Total 7000 saplings have been planted this year in villages, Schools and Hospitals. The survival of all the planted saplings is 90%.

Farmers were distributed kits containing grass cutter, 10 kg fertilizer and other nutrition required for the growth of fodder for demonstration cultivation in their agricultural land. Awareness session on a new hybrid fodder Napier NB 21 & CO4 was also conducted with the farmers.

#### Training on Fodder Development:

In September, a training program on fodder cultivation was organized with 25 farmers of Maringna village in partnership with Kutch Food & Fodder Foundation. The objective was to introduce new methods and techniques of hybrid fodder cultivation that the farmers can easily adopt and can get benefit in long run.



## Health

4 training sessions for project Navchetana has been conducted in September and 22 volunteers attended the session. The topics covered were: Review of work & assessment of nutrition, case studies of villages and discussion on self-identification, breast feeding methods with proper hygiene and posture while feeding and weaning of infant. Also, diet of Pregnant & nursing mothers was touched upon in the trainings.

### Navchetana- Village level activities

Post the household survey conducted in all the villages, the identified target groups' are- 1092 Adolescent girls, 134 pregnant women, 104 nursing mothers & 1485 children ranging between 0-6 years. The volunteers are conducting awareness sessions in groups & one to one counselling through household visits.



### Health check-up for ladies at CSR Centres

In partnership with CHC Anjar, a general medical health check-up of all ladies of 8 CSR centres has been done. They were examined for routine blood investigation, urine testing and BP. Total 84 ladies have been examined.

### Mobile Van Dispensary

September month observed 1720 patients for check up of 19 villages along with Gayatri Niwas Girls' Hostel. Examination, treatment, suggestion & referral was provided.

The team also has also conducted awareness sessions on BP, Malnutrition, Worm infection etc. through pamphlet distribution, one to one counseling and group discussion.

## Empowerment

### Production Details

In 9 centers 105 beneficiaries worked on Shopper Stop, Hyper City, Metro and IHG Pillow Pair, and outsourced orders from Makwana Tailors and Doshi Bags.

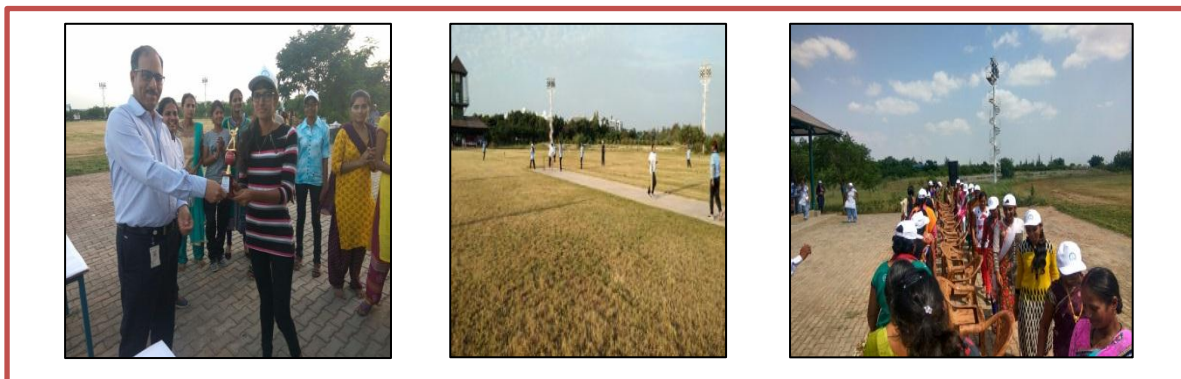
### Sports Events

On 23rd September, a sports event was organized at Anjar Welspun Cricket stadium along with CSR Beneficiaries. The programme started at 9:30 am and hosted

a bunch of sports – Crickets, Musical chair & One minute games etc. where all the beneficiaries had participated.

The event was ended at 6.30 pm with award ceremony and vote of thanks on behalf of Welspun Foundation for Health & Knowledge.

For the first time, a sports event was organized and conducted in a professional way following all the guidelines as per rules. The feedback of the visitors, participants & staff was very positive.



## Model Village

Technical team visited the village and took the measurement for budget estimation. Cleanliness drive has been organized at Ajapar village and 40 Dustbins were put up in designated locations. Street plays were

conducted in both the upcoming model villages on personal health & hygiene and entire community participated in the sessions.

## Education

### Visit to Pannah Hostel and Suniti Girls Hostel:

Welspun Foundation for Health and Knowledge makes an annual contribution towards the education and hostel facilities for 44 tribal children (29 boys and 15 girls) residing at the Pannah Hostel at Ahwa and ensures provision of basic amenities for 55 girls from tribal areas at the Suniti Girls Hostel – Vansda.

## Health

### Project Navchetana

Baseline study was conducted for identifying the malnourished people across children, adolescent girls and women. A total of 35 malnourished children, 69 malnourished girls and 69 lactating

mothers who need special attention for proper nutrition were identified.

The phase 2 of this project will focus on training the project team members and teaching them techniques on how they need to sensitize the beneficiaries on healthy lifestyle, good living and eating habits and knowledge about Body Mass Index.

### Medical Camp at Morai Village

A free medical health checkup camp for all the people of Morai village was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> of September. The children of the village, youth and adults took part and got themselves screened at the camp.

A team of 3 doctors were invited for the camp and conducted the camp from 9am to 2pm. A total of 125 patients were screened at the camp.

## Empowerment

WFHK team at Vapi was invited by the District Science Center at Dharampur, Valsad during their Swachha Pakhawada week celebration, for conducting a session on Health and Hygiene for women. More than 150 adolescent girls and women attended the awareness session. The SETU

group, a SHG established by WFHK was given a stall to sell the sanitary pads made by them. The session was greatly appreciated as it gave in-depth information about hygiene, nutrition and sanitation during menstruation.

### Enhancing and Promoting Education

An education enhancement program for local children was started on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2017 focusing on their personal hygiene, cleanliness and basic education. Since then it is the sessions are been taken every day and about 30 children are taking benefit of this program. A teacher named Ms. Babita and some other volunteers are coming to take this class. Since then there are 25 students on every day basis who attend classes.

Every month 1 medical camp is conducted at worksite area. This initiative was started in March 2017 and till date more than 200 people have taken benefit of this program

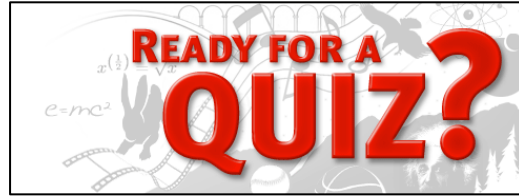


## Award Winning
